Request for Proposals 2015

English as Second Language Courses (Summer and Fall 2015)

All participating undergraduate students and teachers from public higher education institutions will be awarded a full scholarship limited to \$3,500 USD to cover an ESL program of 96 academic hours, with a duration of 4 weeks. That award is all inclusive and is not negotiable. It must include tuition, educational fees, housing, meal program, medical insurance, and all other student services or costs. Learners will receive an additional sum to cover air transportation, passport, student visa and SEVIS fees.

English Teacher Training Courses (Summer and Fall 2015)

All participating teachers from public higher education institutions will be awarded a full scholarship limited to \$4,500 USD to cover a training program of English language teaching for Spanish-speaking people, with at least 96 academic hours during 4 weeks. That award is all inclusive and is not negotiable, and must include tuition, educational fees, housing, meal program, medical insurance, and all other student services or costs. Students will receive an additional sum to cover air transportation, passport, student visa and SEVIS fees.

Professional/Technical English Courses (Summer and Fall 2015)

All participating graduate students and teachers from public higher education institutions will be awarded a full scholarship limited to \$3,800 USD to cover a 96 hours Technical English program in fields such as: engineering, health, finances, telecommunications or law. The award is all inclusive and is not negotiable, and must include tuition, educational fees, housing, meal program, medical insurance, and all other student services or costs. Students will receive an additional sum to cover air transportation, passport, student visa and SEVIS fees.

English for Academic Purposes (Summer and Fall 2015)

All participating graduate students, teachers and researchers from public higher education institutions or public research centers will be awarded a full scholarship limited to \$3,800 USD to cover an EAP program of at least 96 academic hours during 4 weeks. That award is all inclusive and is not negotiable, and must include tuition, educational fees, housing, meal program, medical insurance, and all other student services or costs. Students will receive an additional sum to cover air transportation, passport, student visa and SEVIS fees.









Short Term Research Programs (Summer 2015)

All participating undergraduate students from public higher education institutions will be awarded a full scholarship limited to \$4,000 USD to cover a 4 weeks Short-Term Research program to develop or foster research and innovation skills in science, technology or engineering, under the guidance of faculty members, postdoctoral fellows or advanced graduate students. Students will assist full-time the mentor in an ongoing research project or work collaboratively with the mentor in designing a new project of mutual interest. The award is all inclusive and is not negotiable, and must include tuition, educational fees, housing, meal program, medical insurance, and all other student services or costs. Students will receive an additional sum to cover air transportation, passport, student visa and SEVIS fees.

Pre-Masters Programs (Summer 2015)

All participating undergraduate students from public higher education institutions who wish to pursue a Master's Degree will be awarded a full scholarship limited to \$4,000 USD to cover a 4 weeks Pre-Master or Graduate Pathway program, to prepare for TOEFL, GRE and/or GMAT tests. That award is all inclusive and is not negotiable, and must include tuition, educational fees, housing, meal program, medical insurance, and all other student services or costs. Students will receive an additional sum to cover air transportation, passport, student visa and SEVIS fees.

Short Certificate Programs for Professionals (Summer, Fall and Winter 2015)

All participating active professionals from public or private Mexican companies will be awarded a full scholarship limited to \$4,500 USD to cover a 2 weeks Intensive Certificate program in areas such as: Energy (renewable and nonrenewable), Engineering, Environment, Finances, Health, ICTs, Manufacturing, Materials. That award is all inclusive and is not negotiable, and must include tuition, educational fees, housing, meal program, medical insurance, and all other student services or costs. Students will receive an additional sum to cover air transportation, passport, student visa and SEVIS fees.

Short Professional Stays (Summer, Fall and Winter 2015)

All participating undergraduate students from public higher education institutions will be awarded a full scholarship limited to \$5,000 USD to cover a a professional experience or internship for a period of 1 up to a maximum of 4 months in a Program of your institution or a third partner (public or private), in areas such as: Engineering, Environment, Finances, Health, ICTs, Law, Manufacturing, Materials. Hosting universities should have a strong relationship with the major companies or organizations in the community where they are located. The program should consist on a combination of academic courses and professional experience in the partner companies / organizations. The award is intended to partially cover living costs, educational and administrative fees and must not be understood as all inclusive.
