Proposed revisions to minimum qualifications:

Education: ~~Bachelor's degree in legal assistant or legal studies, or law degree and admission to Minnesota Bar, or bachelor's degree with emphasis or 30 quarter/20 semester credits in legal assistant or legal studies.~~ Bachelor's degree in paralegal or legal studies, or a bachelor degree and 30 semester credits in paralegal or legal studies, or a graduate law degree.

Occupational Experience: ~~One year of relevant work experience at the professional level.~~ Three full time (or equivalent) years of verified related paid experience in the legal field.

~~Additional Requirement: Meets minimum qualifications for accreditation if required.~~

~~Air Traffic Control License Field~~

Inactivation of the Air Traffic Control license field and associated minimum qualifications as there are no active Air Traffic Control programs in the system.
