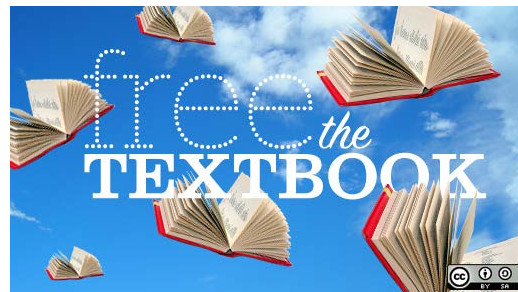

Campus Open Textbook Projects

Grant Availability

Minnesota State Colleges and Universities is seeking applications from system institutions to seven (7) grants of up to \$25,000 to develop or support projects that intend to increase awareness and adoption of Open Textbook materials by faculty.



Purpose

The goal of this grant is to develop or support projects that intend to increase awareness and adoption of Open Textbooks or other Open Educational Resource (OER) materials by faculty. The main goals of these projects should include:

- To increase awareness and adoption of Open curricular materials by faculty as alternatives to higher cost publisher textbooks.
- To lower student textbook costs for those courses included in project proposals.
- To build a foundation for a sustainable model of Open Textbook adoptions on campus.
- To gather evaluation data on meeting the goals of the submitted proposals.

Projects be fully operational or completed by the Fall 2016 term.

Timeline and Process

January 11, 2015	Recipients notified
January 19, 2016	Work begins as soon as possible after this date
