SUBJECT: System Office IT ISRS Software Development Availability for ASA Projects

In planning for fiscal year 2017, ASA & IT Leadership has identified the following known software development work efforts that affect the development teams in the academic and student affairs areas.

To ensure the successful completion of all of the items listed below, IT will be utilizing resources across all ASA software development teams including financial aid, registration, admissions and core services to complete this work. Based on current knowledge of these work efforts the below projects will be ASA/IT Software Development work plan in fiscal year 2017. In the event that ASA & IT Leadership determines, because of project timing, size or scope, resources and time are available to tackle additional work, ASA will be seeking input from all of the academic and student affairs user groups to identify the next highest priority project for IT to address.
