How can your campus build and sustain CPL services?

Credit for prior learning (CPL) is a critical component in helping adult students and other underrepresented populations succeed in obtaining postsecondary credentials.



While we may understand CPL's role in strategic enrollment management and Equity 2030, we also face challenges with developing and sustaining the resources required to implement CPL. What kind of infrastructure works best? What are the resources we need? How do we convince colleagues, leadership, and decision makers about necessary investments?
